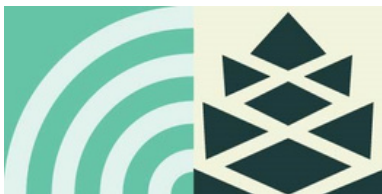
AmeriCorps
