

This Student Activities Assistant supports school athletic and outdoor education programs by helping facilitate a student biking program, tracking equipment issues, and collecting rider data. The role serves as a key communication link between parents, staff, and students regarding athletics, and assists with managing student forms such as medical records and codes of conduct. Additional duties include maintaining outdoor education equipment, supporting the athletic director with scheduling, equipment purchases, and payments, and potentially assisting with coaching and game-day support. Members do not participate in prohibited activities. Members do not supplement, duplicate, or displace staff members at the host site. Members with this program have recurring access to vulnerable populations.

The Idaho HealthCorps (IHC) AmeriCorps program partners community members with non-profits across Idaho. These community members serve in paid volunteer positions called AmeriCorps positions. **The opportunity is offered each year from Sept 1- Aug 31.** Visit idahohealthcorps.com for more information.

REQUIREMENTS:

- Must be 17 years or older
- Must be a US Citizen or Lawful Permanent Resident
- Pass a background check
- Complete 675 hours
- Participate in required training and service events
- Avoid Prohibited Activities
