They will also lead volunteers in sorting and shelving the food items and distribute food directly to the people coming to the food pantry. We hope to attract an organized, dedicated, empathetic, non-judgmental, and motivated teammate. Members do not participate in prohibited activities. Members do not duplicate or displace staff at the Host Site. Members with this program have recurring access to vulnerable populations.

The Idaho HealthCorps (IHC) AmeriCorps program partners community members with non-profits across Idaho. REQUIREMENTS :

- Must be 17 years or older
- Must be a US Citizen or Lawful Permanent Resident
- Pass a background check
- Complete 900 hours
- Participate in required training and service events
- Avoid Prohibited Activities

BENEFITS:

- Living allowance of \$881-1189.80 per month before taxes, distributed biweekly
- Education Award of \$3,697.50
- Student Loan Forbearance and Interest Forgiveness
- Member Assistance Program
